Eligible are the state champions, runners-up, or the highest-ranked (USGP ranking) Colorado riders in these categories: Elite Men, Elite Women, Junior 15-16 and 17-18, and 35+. In case of multiple applications the recipient will be chosen based on the order cited above. Eligible and interested riders should submit a letter of application through the contact link on this web-site. The stipend will be paid as a reimbursement of expenses incurred for travel to National Championships. It will be paid upon submission of receipts for expenses incurred up to \$250 per rider.
